

The Building of the branches

Clips- Alternate clips by 90°

Wedges- Optional Straight or random depending on the look you are going for



Trunk Assembly

Simply alternate the modified brick and the round 1x1 brick – This would be done with the flex tube up the center


Change up the look by adding more 1x1 rounds in






Adding the branches

The longer branches are the ones you want to add the 4L lightsaber blades.



Getting the clearance to attach the branches

Adding 1x1 round brick and plate will give you the space to do this.



How to attach the clip tree branches

Remove one clip from the Travis Bricks closest to the tree trunk on each branch.





Top and Trunk

Adding a cone to the to helps create a nice shape.

At the bottom of the branches,
I like to add the modified
round plate with bars to give
the underside a better more
complete look.

Using technic can give you angles that allows for more interesting shaped trees




Colour and texture
